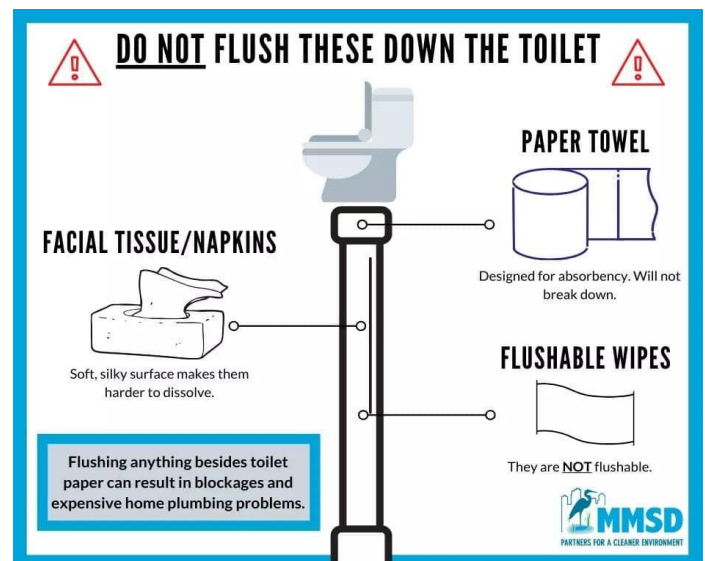

COMMUNITY NEWS

Community Center:

The Community Center will be open for limited hours and programs starting in November. Please see the calendar of events for the days and hours the Community Center will be open.

While the Community Center is open, the lending library will be open to one person at a time. As much as we would love to have you sit back and enjoy your book or puzzle we ask that once you have selected a book or two that you exit the library to make time for your neighbors.

To help ensure the safety of all, the following CDC Guidelines will be required for everyone entering the Community Center:

- Answer screening questions
- Sign in
- Wear a mask at all times while in the building
- Sanitize hands when entering
- Adhere to physical distancing of 6 feet apart
- If you are feeling ill or have been in direct contact with someone that is ill, please stay home
- If you are early for a program/fitness time you will be asked to remain outside until it is your time

All programs will be held in the "Grand Room" to allow for appropriate physical distancing

Fitness Room will be available to use with the following restrictions:

- One person allowed in the fitness area at a time (two if you live in the same home)
- Maximum time for use is 30 minutes
- You must sign up with Andrew for your time (limit 2x per week)
- After use you are required to wipe down the equipment with the provided sanitizing solution

Attention Community Walkers:

- Hunting is NOT permitted on Hillcrest/Pinecrest property, but please be aware that hunting season has begun. If you are walking on the Eastern Trail, or through the woods, please be safe and wear clothing that is blaze orange in color. Report hunters to the office and to the Scarborough Police Department.
- Please be aware of your surroundings and watch for vehicles that may be backing up. Also wear reflective gear when walking from dusk till dawn.

Trash Collection:

Due to the Thanksgiving holiday trash will be collected on Wednesday November 25th. Please make sure to place your barrels curbside by 6:30 a.m.

Bundle up and join us for an outdoor walk right in our backyard along the Eastern Trail. We will meet at the entrance gate of the trail at 9:00 a.m. Our walks last approximately 45 minutes and you go at your own pace.

To help maintain proper physical distancing during these unprecedented times, we will be offering transportation to Hannaford three days a week. Rides will be limited to one passenger at a time with pick-up every thirty minutes. If you have not already done so, please call Andrew (883-2512) to schedule your ride. Do not forget we also carry your bags into the house for you if you would like us to!

Snow Removal

If you would like to hire State Manufactured Homes to plow and shovel, please call Andrew at the office 883-2512 or email andrew@statemanufacturedhomes.com what services you would like.

- Our Plowing Service can also include:
 - Shoveling a path to the front door (please note: does not and cannot include shoveling the entire deck)
 - Shoveling a path to your fuel tank
 - Shoveling a path to your shed
- For us to shovel, you ***MUST*** be signed up for our plowing services.
- Depending on the severity of the storm, paths to the fuel tank and shed may not get done until the following day.
- The office will mail you an invoice the first week of each month for the previous month's charges.
- ***If you were signed up last year, it does not mean you are signed up for this year. Please make sure to sign up again for this year if you wish to hire us.***
- If you were unhappy with our plowing/shoveling services in the past, we may ask you to hire another company that can better meet your needs.

You must call 883-2512 or e-mail Andrew andrew@statemanufacturedhomes.com to be added to the list. If you drop our plowing service, you cannot be added back to the list.

Deadline to sign up for our snow removal services is Friday October 30th.

We are unable to sign up residents who call after Friday October 30th, 2020.
